

# Automated Collection

Welcome to the new way of collecting your trash & recyclables.



**Dear Monaca Borough Resident,**

Waste Management is excited to continue servicing Monaca Borough residents as your waste and recycling hauler. These are your new trash and recycling carts! They are designed to be picked up and unloaded by an automated arm attached to a Waste Management truck.

Beginning the week of July 13, 2020, trash and recycling collection day will be changing for some residents:

**If your address ends in an Odd Number your collection day will be on MONDAY.**

**If your address ends in an Even Number your collection day will be on TUESDAY.**

Please use your new carts the week of July 13, 2020. Place it curbside, following the instructions on the lid, for service on your new service day.

Material outside of the cart will not be accepted. Residents can contact Waste Management to arrange for pick up of additional items outside of the cart. Resident's will be charged for any material placed outside of the cart, and that must be paid for upon scheduling this service:

- Extra Garbage Bag (up to 33 gallon bag) : \$2.00 per bag
- Bulky Items (chair, table, dresser, etc.): \$5.00 per item
- White Goods (refrigerator with freon removed, washing machine, etc.): \$10.00 per item

**Beginning the week of July 13, 2020, recycling will be collected every other week. Your upcoming recycling collection weeks will be:**


**• Week of July 13 • Week of July 27 • Week of August 10**

THIS NEW EQUIPMENT IS DESIGNED TO BE AUTOMATED SO THE DRIVER DOES NOT LEAVE THE CAB. THE TRUCK HAS A MECHANICAL ARM THAT REACHES THE BIN; IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU PLEASE FOLLOW THE PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS ON THE LID EACH TIME YOU PLACE THE BIN OUT FOR PICK UP TO PREVENT ANY INTERRUPTION IN SERVICE.

## Proper Cart Placement

Place your cart at least 3 feet away from all objects including your second cart, mailbox, car, or a tree. The lid opening should face the street with the wheels of the cart facing your house.



Place wheels of cart toward house.

Keep space between carts and other objects.
